HOW TO KEEP A FISH ALIVE

1. Use a single barbless hook, not this

Our game warden calls this *TERMINAL TACKLE*, because it kills the fish.

Pliers at gate for snipping barbs.



2. Handle the fish gently, if possible with a net

Wet your hands, don't squeeze



3. Remove the hook and place the fish back in the water as quickly as possible

• If you want to take a picture, make it fast. Be ready before the fish is out of water.



1/3 of trout out of the water for more than 30 seconds DIE

4. Lower the fish into the water. She should swim away

Wrong way



Last, for the young kids who use hooks and worms that kill fish, I propose that we emphasize the educational value of the pond with a maxim that I was taught as a child and that is embedded in many cultures – don't kill what you aren't going to eat. Prepare the little kids to catch some fish, and then to enjoy them for dinner. It will be a memory they won't forget.
